Bonalbo Tourist Park and Camping Grounds

Woodenbong Road, Bonalbo

This beautiful serene campground is located on the main road to Bonalbo, with a creek bordering behind, and the local swimming pool beside it. Even though it is located on the main road it is not noisy and the sites are large enough to set yourself up comfortably.

Bonalbo Township is a quick walk away, where you will find a Foodworks store, which also does takeaway meals, a chemist, Post Office and hotel. You also have the local bowling club next door to the swimming pool, who are very welcoming to new visitors.

Amenities:

- Toilet block with 3 male and 3 female toilets and showers
- Camp kitchen with microwave and 2 small fridges – would recommend bringing a chill box for food storage
- Coin operated laundry (washing machine and dryer) and clothes line
- BBQ area with tables and shade
- Council rubbish collection

The Gateway Lifestyle is located 5 minutes from the main shopping area in Casino, it has a large camping area in which they welcome backpackers and travellers, in this area alone there are 100 sites. This area has a large amenities block and an undercover area with barbeques. There is a communal kitchen located a little way from this area which you are also able to use for cooking, this area also has a fridge which is free to use, but please be considerate of other campers.

While staying here, you are also welcome to participate in any activities on site or use of other facilities like the swimming pool open 7am – 8pm, clubroom, golf course, games room and café to mention a few.

- Bus to Casino – check with reception for timetable
- Good Telstra reception and WI-FI
- Swimming Pool and access to all other facilities

Mallanganee Memorial Park (Camping Ground)

Sandilands Street, Mallanganee

Mallanganee Park is a community run campground, centrally located between Casino and Tabulam. There is no cooking facilities or power available

Amenities:

- Toilets and showers – a \$20.00 bond is charged for the key and is refundable on return. Key is obtained from the Wild West Store hours Mon-Sat 7.30am-6pm Sun 8am-3pm – opposite the hotel
- Tables under shelter
- NO CAMPING UNDER THE SHELTER

Lanikai Wildlife Refuge and Camping Ground

Pretty Gully – Tabulam

Lanikai Wildlife Refuge and Camping Ground offers 2,500 acres of declared Wildlife Refuge. Home to over 150 bird species, this idyllic location, with its breathtaking views of the Upper Clarence and 2 acres of lush gardens and Walking Tracks, is the perfect place for bird watchers, wilderness enthusiasts and naturalists looking for an authentic wilderness experience. So if you are looking for the most relaxing place around this area, here it is.

Some areas of Lanikai are accessible by 2WD, more by 4WD but all is accessible by foot, such as our 3km of Clarence River frontage. Here the water holes, linked by rapids are home to platypus and waterbirds, while above Brush-tailed rock wallaby peer down from rocky outcrops. Our 2km of Pretty Gully Creek, chuckling and gurgling in its narrow rocky bed, passes through eucalypt and rainforest on its way to join the Clarence, this is also walking country.

On the Camp ground a quiet observer may see honeyeaters, lorikeets, Glossy Cockatoo or Yellow Tailed Cockatoo among the Forest Oak, Tallowwood and Banksias. Redneck Wallaby graze by day, Rufous Bettong and Long-nosed bandicoot may visit by night.

Tents, swags, camper trailers, caravans all find Lanikai a spacious & peaceful site. There is a four cubicle spacious shower block and four toilets. This is a primitive camping ground. No powered sites. No waste dumping.

You can get Telstra phone reception here, but there is no means to charge your phone. Plenty of space, plenty of parking. **NO CAMPING UNDER SHELTER.**

Amenities:

- Hot showers – wood fired
- Shelter with large open fire and seating
- Bush kitchen with a wood burner to heat water
- Gas fridge

Tabulam Race Track – Camping

Race Course Road, Tabulam

If you are up for a swim after a hard day's work, this is the ideal place for you. There are two parts to this camp ground, one down on the flats down by the Clarence River and the other up by the amenities and shelter, some past pickers have camped here in the horse stalls for shelter as NO camping is available in the main sheltered area.

This is a gated secure campground, keys are \$20.00 refundable on return. Please respect this as we don't want cattle let into the premises. Gordon is the caretaker here and is happy to help if needed. There is no waste disposal here but arrangements have been made at River Run to help with disposal.

Amenities:

- Hot showers and flush toilets
- Large sheltered area for cooking and socialising – NO cooking amenities, bring your own cookers etc
- Large fridge
- Washing machine
- Power to charge phones, tablets, laptops etc
- Limited rainwater for drinking

Urbenville Forest Park

Urben Street, Urbenville

This little basic Forest Park is located in Urbenville, close to all services that Urbenville has to offer – general store, local hotel, and garage, all within walking distance.

Amenities:

- 8 powered sites and plenty of unpowered
- 1 unisex shower which you need to pay a \$20.00 bond for a key, refundable on return
- 1 male 1 female toilet
- Woodburner BBQ – bring your own wood
- NO drinkable water
- Maximum stay 6 weeks – can leave for 1week then return for another 6 weeks
